Message #12: "I WILL SEE HIS GOODNESS" PART 3b

June 2, 2019 – 1 Samuel 18:5-9 NLT

2019 DECLARATION: I WILL SEE THE GOODNESS OF THE LORD WHILE I LIVE BUT I MUST WAIT ON THE LORD.

KEYS FOR TODAY'S MESSAGE

MOST of God's people are **NOT** going to experience the blessings of the Word of God because of ① **UNBELIEF** (we don't really believe that God will bless US); ② **DISOBEDIENCE** (God can't trust us to do the right thing with our blessing because we REFUSE to do the right thing NOW); ③ **INSECURITY** (we're too afraid of what people say about us now and this will get worse if we are blessed); ④ **INSTABILITY** (the Lord knows that if He blesses us, He will lose us). ⑤ **FEAR** brought on by any of the prior things. As for me, I WILL see His Goodness! **Today, we will focus on INSECURITY so we can overcome it.**

INSECURITY – lack of confidence and self-doubt about yourself. An insecure person feels that the whole world is watching and waiting to see them fail in something or to attack them about something. An insecure person lives in constant fear of rejection.

More Points About Insecurity

- Your favor with God depends on how you rejoice in the blessings of others. Don't let insecurity make you unhappy for others!
- If you can't be happy when others experience the good things of God, you are cutting off your opportunity for the same thing.
- Insecure people can be arrogant to cover up their insecurities. God won't bless this! (See Proverbs 16:18)
- I MUST overcome my insecurities! My future depends on it or I'll become a distraction in the Body of Christ that must be moved.

✠ CONQUERING INSECURITY ✠

(1) Reject and forsake all insecurities in your life.

- It starts with daily prayer. Keep this issue before God!
- Then make a declaration about YOURSELF and keep doing it. It took you years to get to this level and it's going to take some time to flush it out. Here are some examples:

Psalm 3:6 Amplified *I WILL NOT BE INTIMIDATED or afraid of the ten thousands who have set themselves against me all around.*

Psalm 56:11 NLT *I trust in God, SO WHY SHOULD I BE AFRAID? What can mere mortals do to me?*

Psalm 118:6 KJV *The Lord is on my side; I WILL NOT FEAR: what can man do unto me?*

(2) Saturate yourself with the Word to see who you really are. The Word of God is your lifeline; it's your everything. **Psalm**

119:11 NKJV *Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You.*

(3) Prophecy to yourself. **Ephesians 5:19-20 KJV** *Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; 20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

- Remind yourself of the prophecies over YOUR life. Have you written them down? If you didn't, do you really believe them?
- Stop speaking negativity over yourself. Don't even repeat the things you've heard about yourself in your mind. Reject that word and whoever spoke it.
- Again, grab yourself some Scriptural declarations **daily**. We must FIGHT this thing with the Word! The devil loves to demonstrate before Christians who are afraid because of their insecurities.
